WEST BOUNDARY COMMUNITY FOREST BURSARY

West Boundary Community Forest awards up to **two** bursaries in the amount of **\$3,000** each to West Boundary graduates who plan to study in a post-secondary trades program or academic program at a recognized Canadian post-secondary institution in the 2025-2026 school year.



ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

- 1. BCSS (or home-schooled) student from West Boundary area graduating in 2024/25.
- 2. Be enrolled in, or awaiting acceptance to an accredited post-secondary trades program or academic institution; AND, must begin their program of study by the end of the following calendar year.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- a. High Academic achievement:
 - Provide a copy of your academic transcript
 - · Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher
 - Include any other reinforcing narrative supplied by the applicant

b. Financial need:

- · Letter of recommendation outlining financial need
- · Copy of student loan application
- · Include any other documentation to support financial need

c. **Program of study**:

 Preference given to students pursuing an education in a forestry-related field: Eg. Forest Technician Certification, Heavy Equipment Operator, Degree in Forestry, Registered Professional Forester.

REOUIREMENTS:

- 1. **Provide a short narrative** of non-curricular achievements, interests, hobbies, leadership skills, community volunteerism etc.
- 2. **Submit a 500-word essay** on "The importance of community forests and factors to be considered in managing a community forest".
- Supply a copy of your acceptance letter or enrollment to an accredited postsecondary academic institution, or trades/training school: eg. UBC, UNBC, BCIT, Interior Heavy Equipment School, etc. I
 - If awaiting confirmation of acceptance, please note this in your application
 - Proof of acceptance and/or enrollment must be provided before bursary funds are released to the student

DEADLINE: Submissions must be received by May 30, 4PM, 2025.
