Gibbs Ecosystem Restoration Project K4E004

- Treatment units within this project included converting dense pine stands and overgrown fir/larch stands into open forest and open range.
- South-facing slopes that contained an abundance of dead pine and blowdown.
- Fuel management, opening up traditional grasslands, and improving the overall health were the objectives
- 120–200 stems per hectare left in the fir/larch stands with some fill planting to occur in the lodgepole pine areas.
